MHST Psychoeducation Workshops- October half term



As part of the Family Hub offer, the Mental Health Support Team in Schools are offering a series of parent/carers workshops to provide psychoeducation and support around anxiety and low mood during the October half term across each of our Family Hubs.

The workshops will outline what anxiety or low mood is, the symptoms, and how this impacts children and young people. They will provide support strategies to help manage the physical and emotional feelings of anxiety and low mood.

Workshops are 60 minutes long and will be delivered by the Mental Health Support Team in Schools as part of the Wigan Borough Family Hub offer.

If your child is struggling with anxiety or low mood or preparing for transition, this will be a useful, informative workshop for you! The team look forward to meeting you.
