Every week, children who read at least 4 times at home (for at least 15 mins) and gets their planner signed by a grown up will receive a CHAMPIONSHIP POINT. When children have achieved 12 points, they will get a bronze badge to wear on their ties, which will be given out in our celebration assembly. Children will receive their silver badge when they reach 25 points and gold when they reach 40 points.

Raffle Tickets
For every CHAMPIONSHIP POINT a child achieves, they will also get a raffle ticket (up to 2 per week). At the end of each half term, the class teacher will draw of ticket; that child will win the class prize!
