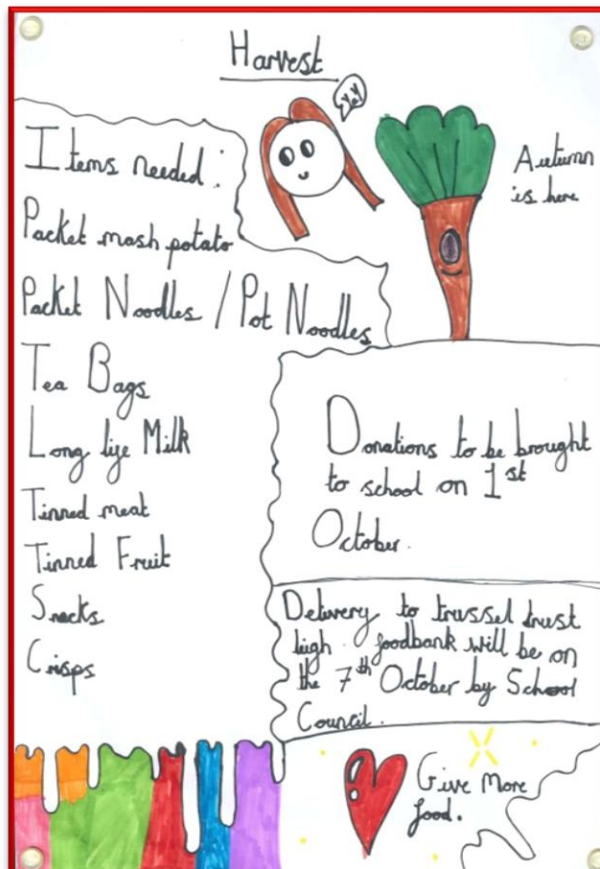
HARVEST FESTIVAL
