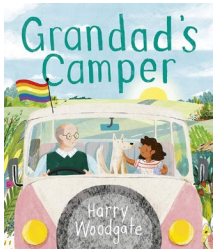


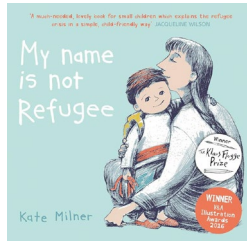

We will develop our writing skills through a range of genres throughout the term.

This term's topics in **Maths** are

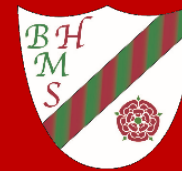
- money

Our **RE** enquiry focus the first half term will be 'Who is an Inspiring Person?' The second will be a Methodist Unit all about Belonging Together.

In **History** our focus will be significant people. We will be researching John Wesley, Queen Victoria, Rosa Parks, Emily Davison and Martin Luther King Jr.

We will identify why they are significant people and look at what impact they have had on the world today. We will also be comparing these significant people by identifying similarities and differences between them.

In **Geography** we will be learning about mapping the world, including the seven continents and five oceans.

We will also be researching Leigh which is a familiar place to us. We will map our journeys to school and find places of interests on maps.
