




We will develop our writing skills through a range of genres throughout the term.

In Poetry we will be studying 'The Jabberwocky' by Lewis Carroll in Autumn 1 and 'Travel' by Robert Louis Stevenson in Autumn 2.

In **music** we will be learning to describe, perform and transcribe, with a focus on 1940's music.

Our **RE** enquiry foci terms:

- Why, where and how do Hindus worship? (Aut 1)
- Can religions help to build a fair world? (Aut 2)

In **PSHE** we will be learning all about positive relationships and valuing difference.

In **computing**, our topics this term are Online Safety, Coding and Spreadsheets.

In **Art** we will develop and refine our drawing and painting skills. We will study art and fashion and look at the work of Piet Mondrian and Yves Saint Laurent. We will use their work as inspiration for our own pieces of art.

In **DT** we will be looking to develop our understanding of complex electrical circuits and even have a go at building our own electrically powered vehicle.

This term's topics in **Maths** are Place Value and Addition, Subtraction and Multiplication & Division. During these topics we will focus on the following skills:

- Numbers to ten million
- Comparing and ordering numbers
- Rounding numbers to 10, 100 and 1000
- Negative numbers
- Written methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

Our first **Spanish** topic is 'Everyday Life'. We'll learn lots of new vocabulary to describe our feelings and every day routines. We will also learn the time.

In Autumn 2, our topic is 'Where I Live, Where You Live'.

In **History**, our first topic is 'A significant turning point in British History: The Blitz'. We will learn all about the events that occurred before, during and after the Blitz. We will also be learning about Alan Turing and Bert Trautmann and how they had an impact on Britain during and after World War 2.

In **Geography** we will be learning about the physical and human geography of the Lake District and comparing it to Granada and Brazil. We will develop our map reading skills and be able to accurately locate places on a map using six figure grid references, as well as interpret Ordnance Survey map symbols.

Our **PESSPA** lessons this term will focus on invasions games (Aut 1) and net and wall games (Aut 2) and will take place on Mondays afternoons.

During daily sessions, we will be practicing distance running and developing our throwing and catching skills.
