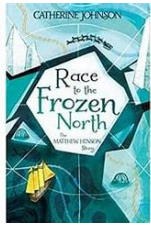


## English

We will develop our writing skills through a range of genres throughout the term.

In Poetry we will be studying 'Chocolate Cake' by Michael Rosen and 'Wynken, Blynken and Nod' by Eugene Field.

In Spanish our topics this term are:

- My School, my subject (Autumn 1)
- Time in the city (Autumn 2)

In Art we will be focusing on the skills of drawing and painting and especially on the work of Ghislaine Howard and the Methodist Artwork Collection to inspire our artwork.

In DT we will be learning how to combine different fabric shapes and working on our sewing skills.

This term's topics in Maths are Place Value, Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication & Division, Statistics, Perimeter/Area. These will focus on the following skills:

- read, write, order and compare numbers to at least 1,000,000 and determine the value of each digit
- round any number up to 1,000,000 to the nearest 10, 100, 1,000, 10,000 and 100,000
- add and subtract whole numbers with more than 4 digits, including using formal written methods
- multiply numbers up to 4 digits by a one- or two-digit number using a formal written method.

# Year 5 Autumn 2025



Our RE enquiry focus will be:

Autumn 1: What are the 5 pillars of Islam?

Autumn 2: How can art, architecture and poetry express belief?

In Music, we will be learning about early notation and musical phrases.

In PSHE we will be learning all about ourselves and our relationships.

In the second half term we will learn about valuing difference.

In computing, our first topic is all about Online Safety and Coding. Our second topic will be Databases.

In History, our focus will be a local history study - the Victorians. We will learn about Victorian life and what this looked like in Leigh as well as learning about Sir Titas Salt which links to the mills in our local area.

We will be carrying out lots of research about the Victorians and comparing what their life was like compared to ours.

In Geography, our focus for this term is locational and place knowledge: global and national. We will be using maps to understand 4-figure grid references.

We will also be looking at physical geography which includes Rivers and Mountains as well as The Water Cycle. We will be using maps, atlases, globes and digital/computer mapping.

Our PESSPA lessons this half term will focus on Invasion games and will take place on Thursday afternoons. During our personal best sessions, we will focus on running for distance.

In Autumn 2, we will learn gymnastics, including different jumps and creating routines with a partner.
