

We will develop our writing skills through a range of genres throughout the term.

In Poetry we will be studying 'If I had wings' by Pie Corbett in Autumn 1 and 'Strict' by Michael Rosen in Autumn 2.

In **Art** we will be focusing on the work of the artists Leonardo de Vinci (1452), Michelangelo (1475) and Raphael (1483) and learning about 'The Renaissance'. We will be using this to create our own sculptures.

In **DT** we will be learning how to make a simple circuit. We will use these to create our own light-up Christmas cards, which we will design, make and evaluate.


This term's topics in **Maths** are Place Value and Addition, Subtraction and Length and Perimeter. During these topics we will focus on the following skills:

- Representing, partitioning, estimating and rounding from 1000 and 10,000
- Ordering numbers using our place value knowledge
- Reading and writing numbers with Roman numerals
- Adding and subtracting using written and mental methods
- Practising times tables up to 12 x 12

Our **RE** enquiry focus will be:

Autumn 1: Can religious teachings help us decide the best way to live?

Autumn 2: How is Christmas celebrated in other cultures?

In **Music**, we will be learning about Musical Structures and exploring feelings when you play.

In **PSHE** we will be learning all about ourselves and our relationships.

In the second half term we will learn about valuing differences.

In **computing**, our first topic is all about Online Safety and Coding. Our second topic will be Spreadsheets.

In **History**, our focus will be the settlements of the Anglo-Saxons and Scots. We will be recapping our knowledge about the Romans and learning what happened next in the timeline. We will be learning about the 7 different kingdoms, Saxon villages and Saxon jobs.

We will be carrying out lots of research about the Anglo-Saxons and Scots and comparing what their life was like compared to ours.

In **Geography** our focus for this term is locational and place knowledge: global. We will be identifying the position and significance of latitude, longitude, the Equator, Northern and Southern Hemispheres. We will also look at the Tropics of Cancer, Capricorn, Arctic and Antarctic Circle, Prime/Greenwich Meridian and Time Zones. We will be using maps, atlases, globes and digital/computer mapping.

Our **PESSPA** lessons this half term will focus on Invasion games and will take place on Monday afternoons. During our personal best sessions, we will focus on running for distance.

In Autumn 2, we will learn gymnastics, including different jumps and creating routines with a partner.
