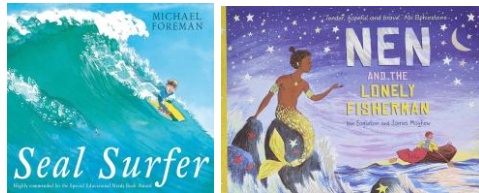


## English

Our Pathways to Write books this term:

We will develop our writing skills through a range of genres throughout the term.

In **Poetry** we will be studying 'If pigs could fly' by James Reeves in Autumn 1 and 'Praise song for My Mother' by Grace Nichols in Autumn 2.

In **Art**, we will develop our drawing skills and will create line art in the style of Picasso and Christina Quarles.

In **DT**, we will be making our own soup. We will follow the design process: research, food preparation skills, design, make and improve. We will learn how to prepare food safely by learning how to chop, slice and dice vegetables for our soup.

This term's topics in **Maths** are Place Value, Addition & Subtraction and Multiplication and Division. We will be also covering some areas of shape. Some skills will focus on are:

- Represent/partition numbers to 100 then to 1,000
- Estimating
- Ordering/comparing
- Add/subtract 1's, 10's and 100's
- Add and subtract two numbers with no exchange
- Add/subtract a 2-digit number from a 3-digit number
- Multiples of 2, 5 and 10
- Multiply and divide by 3, 4 and 8

Our first **Spanish** topic is learning how to count to 10, we will also learn various greetings and farewells.

We will learn how to ask and respond to questions including: how are you?

In **music** we will be learning to describe, perform and compose.

Our **R.E.** enquiry foci are: What Makes Some Books Sacred?

Our **PESSPA** focus for this term will be swimming. This will take place on Monday afternoons.

Our personal best target focus will be: running for distance and throwing for distance. We will record our new PB's weekly.
