




We will develop our writing skills through a range of genres throughout the term.

In Poetry we will be studying 'Don't Call Alligator Long-Mouth Till You Cross River' in Autumn 1 and 'Give Yourself a Hug' in Autumn 2.

In **music** we will be learning to describe, perform and transcribe, with a focus on 1960's music.

In **PSHE** we will be learning all about ourselves and our relationships.

In the second half term we will learn about valuing differences.

In **computing**, our first topic is all about Online Safety and Coding.


In **Art** we will be focusing on the work of the artist Claude Monet and will be using his work of 'Poppies' to develop printing and painting techniques as well as learning about the warm and cool colour palette.

In **DT** we will be exploring mechanisms, wheels and axels. We will be designing and creating our own forms of transport.

This term's topics in **Maths** are Place Value and Addition, Subtraction and Shape. During these topics we will focus on the following skills:

- Numbers to 100
- Comparing and ordering numbers
- Counting in 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s
- Adding and subtracting two two-digit numbers
- Recognising and counting sides, vertices, faces and edges on a range of 2D and 3D shapes

Our **RE** enquiry focus the first half term will be How do we show we care for others? The second will be Why and How are Christmas and Chanukah celebrated?

In **History**, our focus will be significant events. We will be learning about the Gunpowder Plot, the Plague (also Covid-19) and World War One. We will be learning about the key things that occurred during these events and putting these into chronological order on timelines. We will be looking at how they impacted on every day life and the world.

In **Geography** we will be learning about Mapping the world, including how we use globes, maps, satellites and a compass rose. We will also be learning about the United Kingdom, including learning about the four countries in the UK and the capital cities, flags and surrounding seas.

Our **PESSPA** lessons this half term will focus on target games and will take place on Tuesday afternoons. During daily sessions, we will be practicing distance running and increasing our stamina.
