

Communication & Language

We will be learning to listen carefully with lips closed. We will be focusing on clear speech, speaking in full sentences and developing our vocabulary. We will also work on understanding and recall of stories.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

We will be working on sharing and turn taking skills. We will be making new friends and learning about our class value of Teamwork.

Literacy

We will be enjoying lots of stories about families and our main text, 'Peace at Last'. We will be working on Phase 2 phonics, letter formation, CVC word building, reading of High Frequency Words (HFWs) and using phonics to decode CVC words. This will be through our Read, Write, Inc phonic sessions, sharing of stories and fine motor control activities.

Physical Development

We will be working on moving and making shapes in our P.E. sessions. We will be developing our gross motor skills by riding bikes and using large fixed equipment. We will also be working on activities that develop our fine motor skills.
