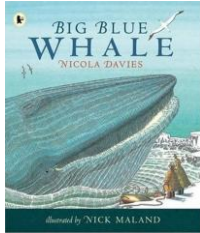
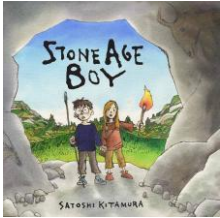

Our Pathways to Write books this term:

We will develop our writing skills through a range of genres throughout the term.

In Poetry we will be studying 'Oh The Places You'll Go' in Spring 1 and 'Please, Mrs Butler' in Spring 2.

In **music** we will be exploring musical instruments and their materials, and to describe, perform, transcribe and compose.

In **PSHE** we will be learning all about growing and changing.

In the second half term we will learn about keeping safe.

In **computing**, our first topic is all typing and email, and our second is about branching databases.

In **Art** we will be focusing on the work of the artist Megan Coyle and will be using her work of 'Culture' to develop collage techniques.

In **DT** we will be exploring electrical systems, and creating our own robot that is controlled using code.

This term's topics in **Maths** are Multiplication and Division, Money, Statistics, Length, Perimeter, Fractions and Mass and Capacity. During these topics we will focus on the following skills:

- Counting in 3s, 4s and 8s.
- Measuring in metres and centimetres.
- Measuring perimeter
- Unit and non-unit fractions
- Measuring in grams and kilograms
- Measuring in litres and millilitres

Our **RE** enquiry focus the first half term will be What do people believe God is like? The second will be What matters to Christians about Easter?

History

Our focus this term will be the Roman Empire and its impact on Britain.

We will be looking at the reasons why the Romans invaded Britain, and creating timelines to understand the chronology of what happened. We will also be learning all about Boudicca's revolt and thinking about her aim.

In **Geography** we will be learning about Location and place knowledge: National. We will be naming and locating counties and cities of the UK. We will also be identifying human and physical characteristics, topographical features, land-use and how these have changed over time.

-Use maps, atlases, globes and digital/ computer mapping.

Our **PESSPA** lessons this half term will be swimming and will take place on Monday afternoons. **PLEASE NOTE: swimming will finish at Feb half term.**

During daily sessions, we will practice throwing for accuracy. In the second half term, we will be focusing on Invasion Games.
