We will develop our writing skills through a range of genres throughout the term.

In Poetry we will be studying 'Why did you come here?' by Trina Graves, which will link with our learning around Spirituality. In Spring 2, we will be learning 'Island Man' by Grace Nichols.

In Music, we will be learning about composing with friends and feelings through music.

In PSHE we will be learning all about 'Growing and Changing'

In the second half term we will learn about valuing differences.

In computing, our first topic is all about different audiences to communicate. Our second topic will be Learning to Code.

In Art we will be studying the artist L S Lowry by looking at a variety of his work and then using his techniques to produce our own piece of art.

In DT we will be focussing on 'Healthy and Varied Diet-Dips'. The children will be tasting and evaluating some dips; creating a product design for their own dip; writing instructions on how to make this and creating their own.

This term's topics in Maths are Multiplication and Division; Length and Perimeter; Fractions and Decimals. During these topics we will focus on the following skills:

- Multiplication and division facts for 1-12 times table
- Multiplying and dividing by 10 and 100
- Multiplying and dividing 2 and 3-digit numbers
- Calculating the length and perimeter of shapes
- Mixed number fractions and improper fractions
- Converting decimals and fractions

Our RE enquiry foci will be:
Spring 1: Methodist Unit 'Warm Hearts' which includes John Wesley's life.
Spring 2: Easter - How could 'The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe' book be an allegory of the Christian story of Easter? Key Concept - Salvation

In History, our focus will be the Vikings and their struggle for the Kingdom of England, up until the time of Edward the Confessor. We will be placing important events, artefacts and historical figures on a timeline, identifying why Vikings came to Britain and where they came from. We will also be identifying what Viking life was like and looking at the Bayeux Tapestry. We will finish the unit by writing a non-chronological report using all the facts we have learned about the Vikings.

In Geography we will be using our geography skills learned in Autumn term to look at allocation in Europe: The Province of Granada in Spain. We will improve our human and physical geography skills by looking at settlements and land use and we will then compare the geographical similarities and differences to Liverpool.

Our PESSPA lessons this half term will focus on outdoor and adventurous activities.

In Spring 2, we will be learning about net and wall games.

Our daily sessions will focus on throwing for accuracy.
