

In **English**, our 'Book as a Hook' is 'Macbeth' by William Shakespeare. We will use this book as inspiration for our writing.

We will continue to learn how to use and apply various SPaG features to our writing such as cohesive devices, using the passive voice and using colons and semi-colons.

We will practise writing in a range of genres including:

- Narrative -story opening
- Playscripts
- Newspaper Reports
- Letter writing (in character)

We will also be doing a project on the book 'Can I be your dog?' by Troy Cummins.

In **Art** we will be developing our printing skills. We will study the artist Angie Lewin, taking inspiration from her work for our own printing.

In **Design Technology** we will be looking at frame structures, spending time designing, making and evaluating

Our topics in **Maths**: Ratio, Fractions, Position and Direction, Decimals and Percentages. During these topics we will focus on the following skills:

- Adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing fractions.
- Finding fractions of amounts
- Quadrants, translations and reflections
- Multiplying and dividing decimals by 10, 100 and 1000.
- Converting decimals and percentages to fractions and vice versa
- Finding percentages of amounts

We will also practise arithmetic and times tables skills daily.
