English

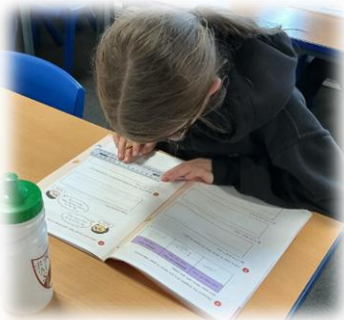
This term in Year 3, we have been focusing on strengthening our foundational skills. Maths

We have been busy in Maths learning all about length and perimeter. We have worked hard on measuring accurately and using a ruler to draw a straight line.

We've also been practising our key skills every morning in our 'fluent in five' sessions. Our maths knowledge is improving all the time!



Science

In Science, we have been learning all about light and shadows. We explored how we need light in order to see, and that darkness is simply the absence of light. We also learned that light reflects from surfaces, how shadows are formed when an object blocks light, and how the size of a shadow can change depending on how close it is to the light source. We even discussed how sunlight can be dangerous and ways we can protect our eyes.

Art & Design

This term in art, we have been exploring the world of collage and studying the inspiring work of Megan Coyle. We developed our skills by creating our own pieces influenced by her unique style. After painting vibrant watercolour backgrounds, we layered our carefully crafted, animal-inspired collage elements on top.
