

Autumn 2 - Pre-School

We've had another busy half term in Pre-school. We have been finding out about the seasons of Autumn and Winter, and learning about the different festivals that happen at this time of the year.

Communication and Language

We have explored different types of pumpkin, what happens in Autumn/Winter and described what we can see and hear in Autumn. As well as working on our listening and attention skills in listening to a wide range of stories.

PSED

We have explored our senses and used all of them to explore Autumn. Alongside this we have played turn taking games, and worked on sharing our toys.

Physical Development

We have been so lucky this half term as we received some new wheeled toys, including a balance bike, scooter and trike. Using our new toys we have spent time on both the KS1 and KS2 playgrounds exploring what they can do, and how physical exercise affects our bodies.



Literacy

We have been reading the story of We're Going on a Leaf Hunt. We have retold the story, and created a story map to help us with the retelling.

Maths

We have enjoyed creating repeating pattern using Autumnal items and through leaf printing. We have also been on a shape hunt finding triangles and circles.



Understanding the World

Each week we have had a cooking session, which we have really enjoyed. We also found a potato in our vegetable patch, so we explored what we could do with potatoes and decided on making crisps which we ate for snack. We have explored pumpkins, before making pumpkin soup with the left over flesh.

This half term has been a busy one for festivals, we celebrated Bonfire Night, Diwali and Remembrance, before starting to work on our Christmas performance and the Christmas Story.
