

## Autumn 2 - 2 Year Old Nursery

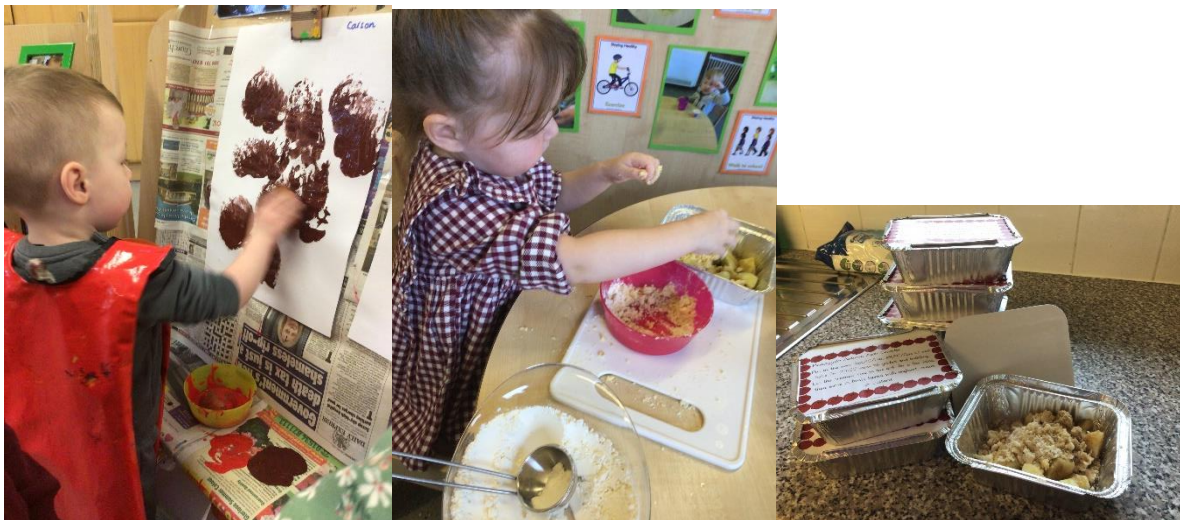
We can't believe that we are nearing the end of 2021 already! This half term has been super busy, let us share some of our highlights with you...
