

In English, our 'Book as a Hook' will be: The Incredible Book Eating Boy! We will use this book for inspiration in our creative writing. We will learn how to apply various SPaG features to our writing such as commas in a list. We will focus on using interesting and ambitious vocabulary, choosing the most appropriate synonyms to up-level our work.

We will write for a number of different purposes e.g. to inform, to persuade and to entertain.

We will also write our own non-fiction texts, using our wider curriculum to inspire our writing including instructions on how to make soup.

We will also study and perform poetry.

In computing, we will be focusing on online safety and learning how to code.

In DT, we will be developing our cooking skills and learning how to make a healthy, delicious soup.

Our Geography focus for this term is: Global location and place knowledge. We will learn how to locate countries, continents and major cities on a map. We will use our Geographical skills to identify key physical and human features.

In History, we begin our first topic: Changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age. We will focus on settlements, conflict and daily life in these time periods.

Our R.E. enquiry focus this term is: What Makes Some Books Sacred?
