

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be working on exploring all of the areas in our classroom and developing our independent skills which includes tidying up when we have finished. We will continue to focus on routine and boundaries for all children.

We will promote independence further by encouraging responsibility in small tasks, helping yourself to a drink using the water tank and putting on our own clothes.

We will be looking at animal safety as we will have a visit from curious critters to help us understand different animals and the dangers they may cause if we don't act safely around

Physical Development

Daily opportunity to ride bikes, scooters and trikes. Climbing and balancing equipment outdoors.

Becoming more independent in putting coat on and other types of clothing including shoes.

Daily access to playdough and other malleable activities to support development of finger muscles. Children will be supported with toilet training should they become ready over the term. We will also be starting our teeth cleaning program!

Literacy

Children will explore new texts throughout the term such as room on the broom, Dear Zoo, Dear Santa and Stick man!

Children will celebrate Nursery Rhyme week during the week beginning 14th November. We will explore a different rhyme everyday, keep an eye out for further information.

Children will be prompted to join in with nursery rhymes, fill in natural pauses, discuss their favourites and create a performance for our parents and carers!

Understanding the World

We will be having a visit from the 'Curious Critters!' This will spark lots of curiosity amongst the children and allow opportunities to discuss animal safety. We will also be exploring lots of Winter textures through various tuft tray experiences.

Communication and Language

We will develop our listening skills and will be working on retelling stories and anticipating the main events.

As always we put a huge emphasis on communication and language so will be engaging children in a range of speaking and listening activities in line with the Keys to communication program and completing Wellcomm activities..

We will explore new texts together and introduce new language alongside this.

We will be introducing our teeth cleaning program so we will use lots of videos and books to help children understand the importance of oral hygiene.

Expressive Arts & Design

Children will explore bonfire night and fireworks! They will create representation using paint and glitter. We will also explore patterns using coloured sand and explore childrens understanding of colours. We will also create a poppy wreath together. We will explore remembrance day together using lots of videos to aid childrens understanding Christmas is also only around the corner which means lots of creative opportunities.

Mathematics

Children will be exposed to number language during their play. We will explore counting in order to 5 through number rhymes. We will use language such as more, less, lots, big, small, empty full during play in the sand, water. Small group maths activities will be completed every morning.
