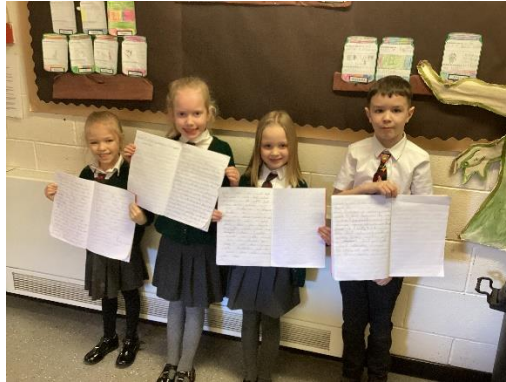


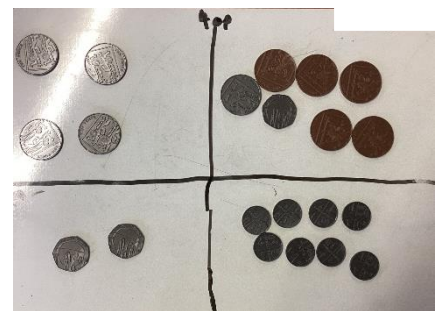
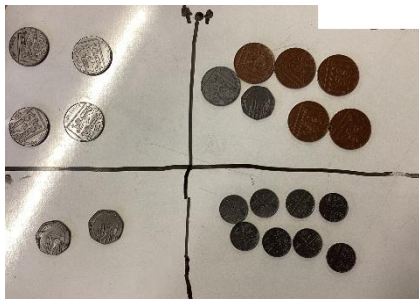
Year 2 - Spring 1

What another busy half term we have had in Year 2!

In English, we have continued to base our work around the book 'Pretty' as we really enjoyed this story. We have written our own recount of the story and planned and written a narrative with our own settings and characters. We have worked really hard with our sentences by thinking of 'WOW' adjectives, using exclamation sentences, full stops and capital letters.



In Maths, we have finished our learning on addition and subtraction and have been learning about money. We have been recognising coins and notes and talking about their value. We have been counting coins including pounds and pence and combining with notes to create a total. We have been trying really hard to make an amount of money in different ways and this is something we will continue to work on - maybe you could practise this at home!



In Computing, we have been creating spreadsheets. We have also celebrated Safer Internet Day this half term. We read a story called 'Hanni and the Magic Window' and discussed the key messages of the story, including how the internet is an amazing place but we need to use it sensibly and cautiously. We also thought about the people we trust to tell if we see anything upsetting or unusual online.



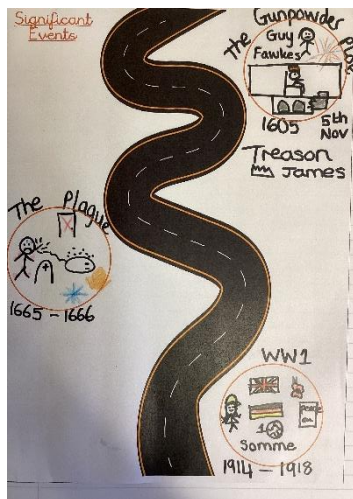

In Geography, we have finished our learning a City and Village comparison where we have been comparing Liverpool and Eyam by discussing what it would be like living there and identifying human and physical features in each place.

In History, we finished our 'Significant Events' topic. We have learnt so much about The Gunpowder Plot, The Plague and WWI and have loved our learning on this. The children are able to recall lots of facts about these using their own road maps.
