What a busy first half term we have had in Year 2! We have been settling back into working together after the summer holidays. It's been great to be back learning together and seeing all our friends again.


English

Maths

In Maths, we have been learning about place value. We have been representing numbers within 50 and 100 using tens and ones. We been identifying how many tens and ones in numbers, partitioning these and finding different ways to make numbers. We have also been writing number sentences for these.



History and Geography

In Geography, we have learnt about mapping the world. We have found out what maps, atlases, globes and satellites are and how they help us. We have also learnt about a compass rose and the directions North, East, South and West. We went outside and identified what we could see in each of these direction. In History, we have learnt all about the Gunpowder Plot, including the key events and found out about the Palace of Westminster.
