

In English, we will continue our work around the book 'Stone Age Boy'. We will use this book to inspire our own creative writing. We will be using our SPaG knowledge to apply commas and apostrophes for contractions to our writing. We will also learn how to use inverted commas in our writing.

We will also study the poem "oh the places you will go" by Dr. Seus.

In Art we will be studying Megan Coyle (1988) This links to our curriculum driver of Culture. We will focus on symbolic animals and use her work as inspiration to create our own pieces of art work.

Our History topic will be The Roman Empire and its impact on Britain.

Our Geography topic will now be National location and place knowledge.
