

## English

This half term we will be finishing our writing based on the book 'Our Tower' by Joseph Coelho. We will be applying everything that we have learnt so far about fronted adverbials and speech to write a diary entry from the view point of one of the characters in the story. We will then be moving onto our next book 'Amazing Islands' by Sabrina Weiss & Kerry Hyndman. We will also be learning the poem 'Island Man?' by Grace Nichols.

## PE

The children will be covering net and wall games.

## Maths

This half term we will be learning about fractions including equivalent fractions, adding and subtracting fractions and fractions of a quantity. We will also be continuing to practise our times tables for our multiplication check in the summer term.

## History

This term we will continue to learn about the Vikings and their struggle for the Kingdom of England, up until the time of Edward the Confessor.

## Geography

We will be using our Geography skills learned in Autumn term to look at allocation in Europe: The Province of Granada in Spain. We will improve our human and physical geography skills by looking at settlements and land use and we will then compare the geographical similarities and differences to Liverpool.

## Design & Technology

We will be focussing on 'Healthy and Varied Diet-Dips'. The children will be tasting and evaluating some different dips. They will create a product design for their own dip, write instructions on how to make this and use a range of cooking techniques to create their own dip. They will then taste it and evaluate to identify things that went well and things that could be improved next time.
